

Jan MICHL (*1946) is a professor emeritus of design history and theory at The Oslo School of Architecture ([AHO](#)), Norway, and former adjunct professor at the Institute of Design at the Gjøvik branch of the Norwegian University of Science and Technology (NTNU). Until 2014, more than a decade, he also conducted week-long autumn design theory workshops at the Academy of Arts, Architecture and Design ([VŠUP](#)) in Prague, The Czech Republic.

He was born in former Czechoslovakia, nowadays The Czech Republic, and educated at the Purkyně, now Masaryk University of Brno, (PhDr., 1975), and at the University of Uppsala in Sweden (fil.kand, 1971), with art history, languages, and economic history as his principal subjects. He has lived in Norway since 1981.

His research interests lie in the field of design theory, more specifically within the theory of modernist design, its critiques and its alternatives.
